Percent of children ages 0 through 17 who are adequately insured

SUMMARY OF STRATEGIES FROM STATE ACTION PLANS

15 jurisdictions selected NPM-15:

Common themes → Importance of outreach, enrollment expertise and insurance adequacy

- Plans must offer robust benefit packages that meet the specific needs of children and families, including families with children and youth with special health care needs (CYSHCN)
- Jurisdictions must provide targeted outreach to vulnerable populations, including families with CYSHCN
- Title V staff and providers must have general knowledge of enrollment and coverage options

Federal issues to consider:

- Adequacy of children's coverage in qualified health plans in the insurance marketplaces
- Expiration in 2017 of funding for the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)
- Expiration in 2019 of the ACA Maintenance of Effort (MOE) provision, whereby states must keep the same eligibility levels for children in Medicaid/CHIP that were in place when the ACA was signed into law
