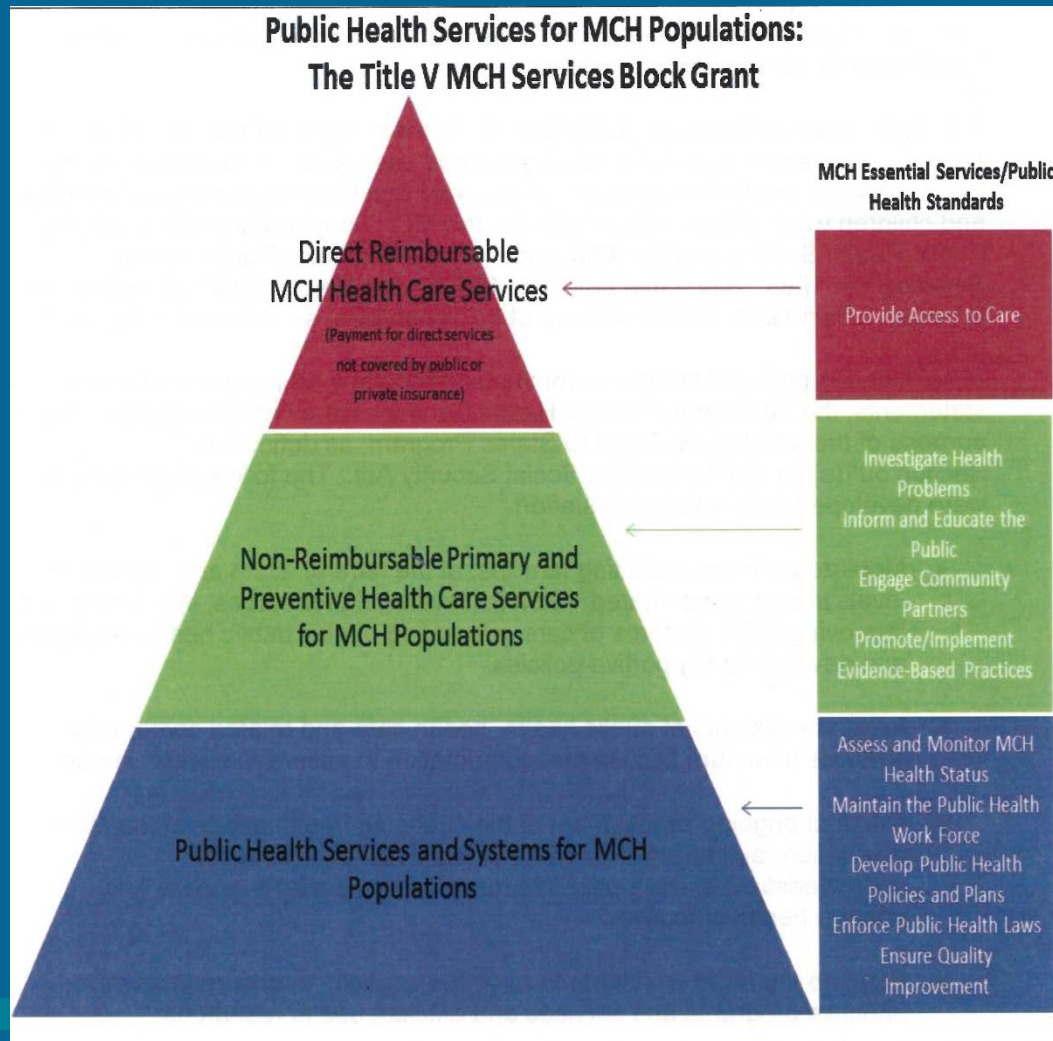

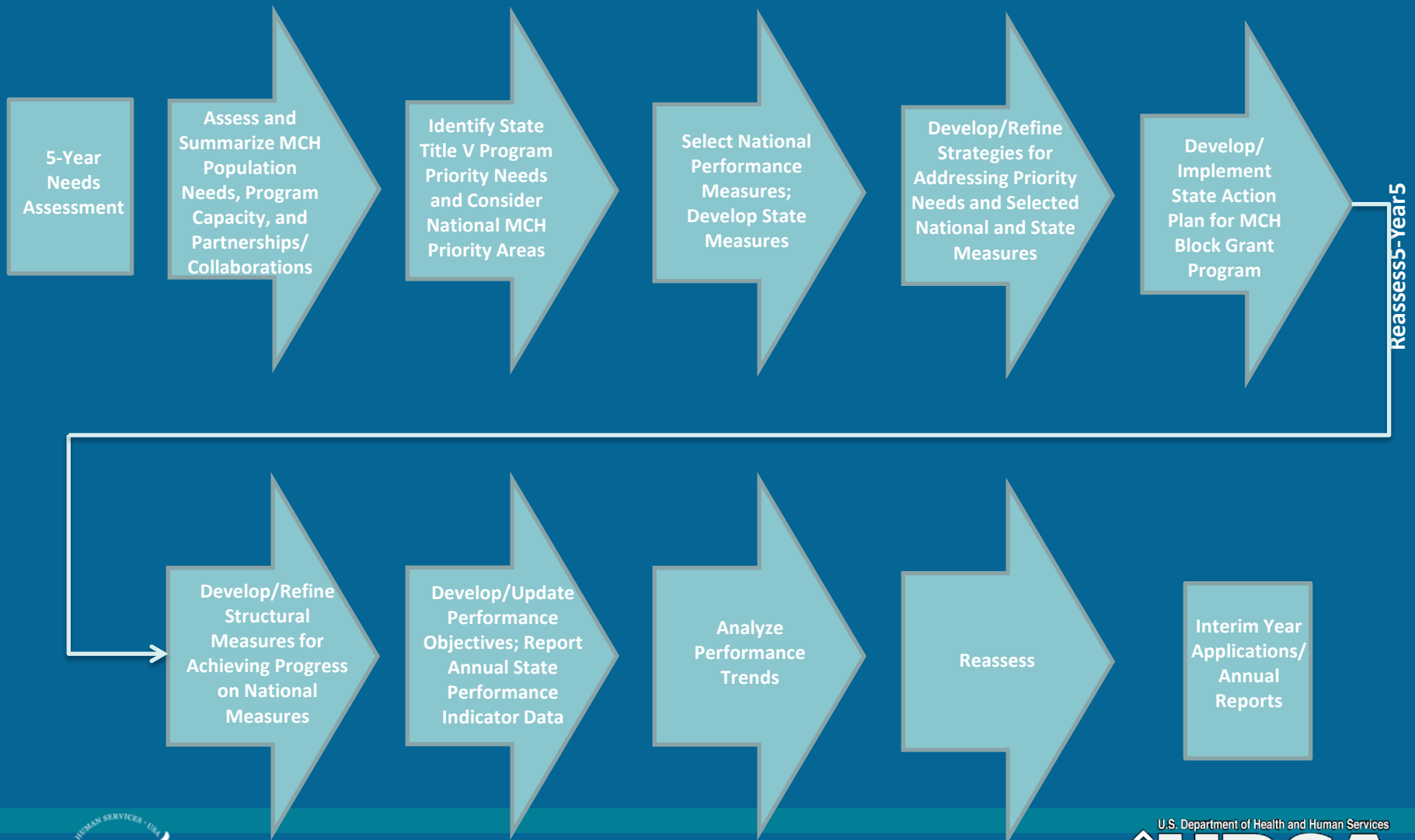

  - New accountability framework



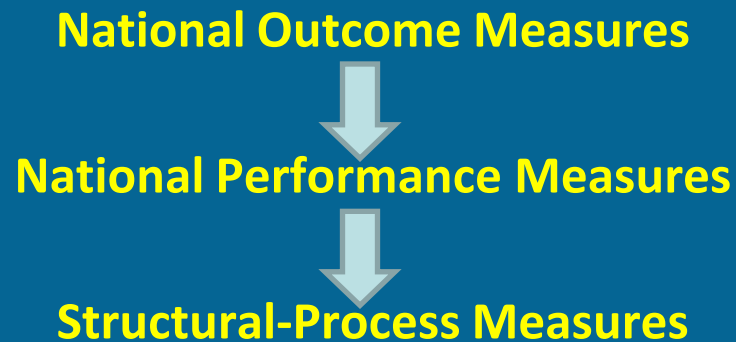
