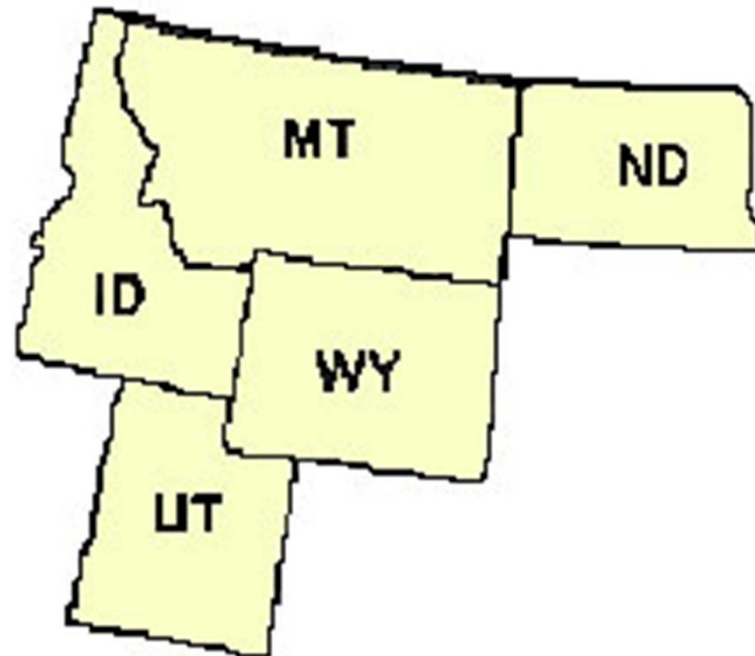

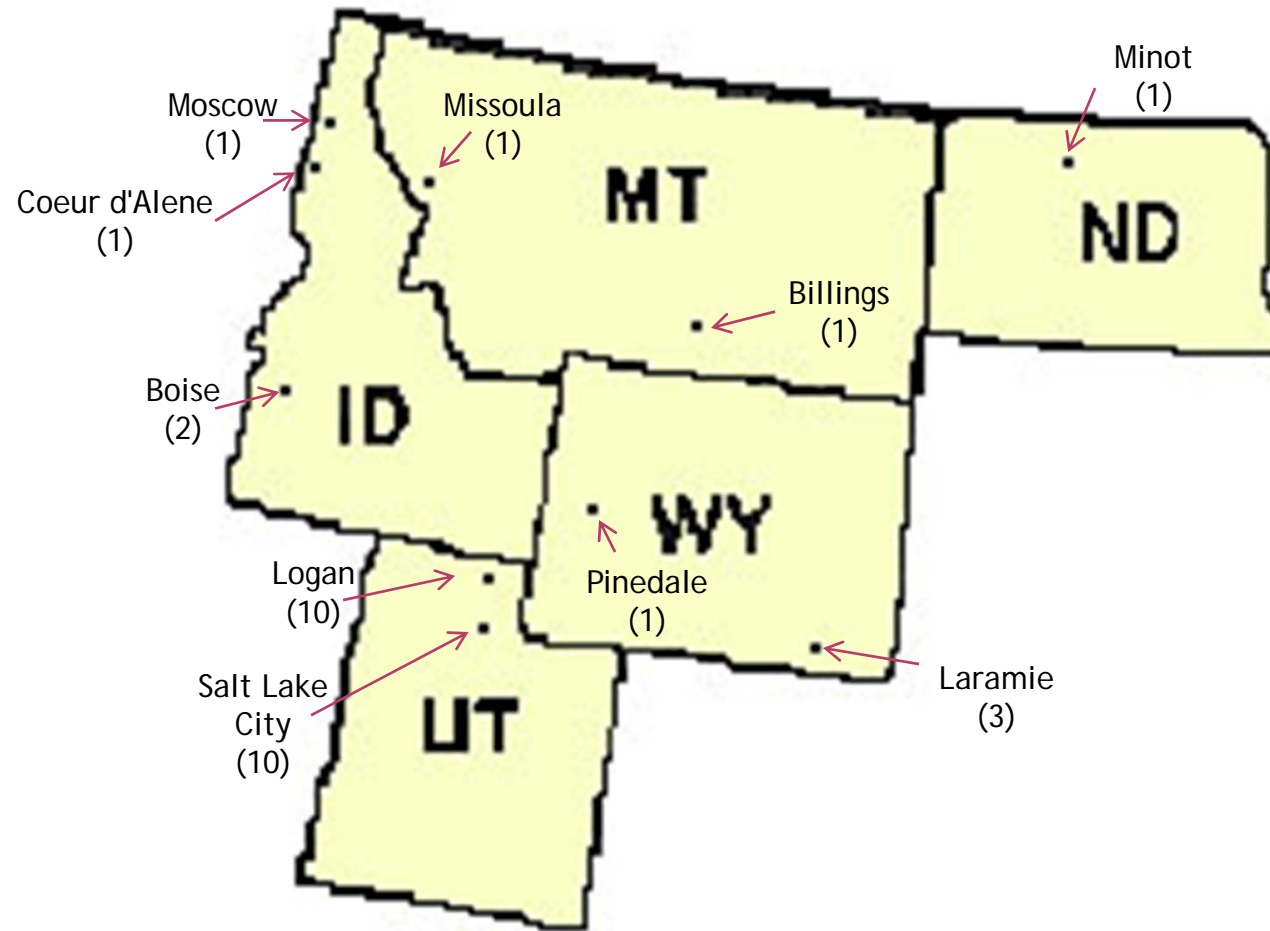

TECHNOLOGY

- ◉ WIMBA
 - Virtual classroom environment with features that include audio, video, application sharing and content display and MP4 capabilities.
- ◉ Journal Reading Group
 - As part of the URLEND-AE curriculum and training, journal readings and discussion were added as a way to actively involve AE trainees in the learning process. One way to measure performance is to actively involve trainees in the discussion process. This was accomplished over interactive video conferencing (WIMBA) and teleconferencing. Trainees were instructed to carefully read the article following the Evidence Based Practice guidelines previously discussed in URLEND. Each trainee was involved in the real-time discussion of the article and was able to relate the article to current practices and other didactic sessions in the AE curriculum.

PARENT DIRECTED CONSULTATION

- The Parent Directed Consultation (PDC) is an interdisciplinary experience for URLEND trainees. Parents provide a list of current questions about their child with a disability and a team of trainees then have a conversation with the parents to provide suggestions and recommendations. Parents provide the focus of concerns and the direction of the conversation.
